The AVDC recently developed a fellowship program to recognize and promote highly skilled specialists with expertise in the most complex oral and maxillofacial surgery techniques. There are currently less than twenty AVDC Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Fellows worldwide.

Dr. Taney completed a rigorous two-year fellowship program and passed its board examination in May 2022 to become an AVDC Fellow, Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. She has been a partner at the Center for Veterinary Dentistry and Oral Surgery since 2008 and became a Diplomate of the American Veterinary Dental College in 2008 as well. Much of her career has been dedicated to the treatment of complex maxillofacial disorders including trauma, oral oncologic surgery, and reconstructive surgery. She has authored numerous publications on advanced oral surgery, including a recent study on reconstruction of hard palate defects.
